Thank you for inquiring about the City of Auburn Hills CDBG Minor Home and Mobile Home Repair Grant Programs. Enclosed is an application packet for you to complete.

No repairs will occur on homes currently for sale, in foreclosure or for repairs to improve home for sale. Approved repairs are based on greatest need. There is a \$5,000.00 lifetime cap per residence. This amount is effective 6/2020 and subject to change without notice depending on availability of funds.

Remember to enclose the requested documentation with your completed application. Failure to enclose all requested documentation will result in delay of application processing.

Once your application and documentation has been received and reviewed by this office you will be notified if your application has been approved and moved on to the next phase.

During the second phase a program administrator will visit your home to review your requested home repairs and verify the scope of work is within the guidelines of the Minor Home Repair Program. At that time the job scope will be developed and beforehand pictures will be taken.

After the home visit within about 10 days you will receive information to start collecting quotes, a job scope and a list of contractors who participate in our program.

**Do not secure and submit price quotes prior to approval as those quotes are void.**
