Dumpster Fire 03/01/2024

Auburn Hills Fire Department was called for a trailer on fire on the shoulder of M59 near I75. A truck was hauling a large dumpster full of construction materials that had caught fire. Firefighters used a combination of 700 gallons of water and foam to completely extinguish the fire. The pickup

truck had no fire damage, but the sides of the dumpster displayed heat damage. The crew had to remove a large amount of debris from the dumpster to ensure the fire was completely out. The driver of the truck cleaned the debris from the side of the road.
