Vehicle Crash

6/5/2024



First responders were dispatched to a vehicle accident with injuries. Multiple callers reported a vehicle went airborne at the Lapeer ramp on northbound I75. Witnesses saw the vehicle travel up the embankment and over the southbound ramp to Lapeer Rd., landing in a wooded area. Upon arrival, the crew found the driver seriously injured and needed to be extricated from the vehicle. The patient was immediately transported to the hospital for further treatment.

OCMCA Award

6/6/2024

Firefighter Edwin Prado was given the Achievement in Excellence Award by Oakland County Medical Control Authority, which governs EMS operations. FF Prado responded to a 911 call, performing lifesaving skills to a critical patient. Congratulations Edwin on your well-deserved award!



Vehicle Fire

6/11/2024

The department was called for a vehicle fire on the southbound side of I75 and Baldwin Rd. Responders arrived to find a 4-door sedan on the left shoulder with smoke and flames coming from the engine compartment. All occupants had safely escaped. Engine 2 crew used the front bumper line to extinguish the fire. The extrication spreaders were used to force open the engine compartment to better access the flames. The fire was completely extinguished, and a thermal imaging camera confirmed there were no hot spots. No injuries were reported.

Duckling Rescue

6/22/2024

C shift was called to rescue 6 baby ducks from a storm drain. A concerned citizen waived down Engine 1 and alerted them to the location of the wayward ducklings. After extricating 5 ducks, one duckling proved to be a bit more difficult and had to be flushed from the drain tube using a 2.5 hose on low PSI, but was eventually rescued with all its siblings. Local neighbors assisted the firefighters with successfully relocating all 6 ducklings to a nearby pond.



Structure Fire

6/24/2024

A caller reported a structure fire at Airboss Flexible Products. First responders arrived to find a working fire in the middle of the plant. Engine 1 crew stretched a 400' hose preconnect from the rear of Engine 1 into the plant. The sprinkler system effectively controlled the fire, and AHFD successfully knocked the fire out. Rochester Hills and Bloomfield Township Fire Departments arrived to assist but were quickly cleared. Command arrived and assisted with ventilation and returning the equipment to Engine 1. Inspector Toss, upon investigation, determined the fire had occurred from the oil on the hydraulic lines of the machine which spread to the ceiling, traveling approximately 40-60 feet before being suppressed by the sprinkler system.

Community Relations Event

6/28/2024

AHFD participated in a community relations event for one of our neighborhoods. Westbury Village Townhomes hosted a last day of school pool party for the residents. They requested a drive-by from one of our fire trucks. Captain Hazelton was able to attend, taught the children how to spray a fire hose, and handed out stickers and hats to the kids.
