RULES FOR BONFIRES:

- 1. Bonfire must be 50 feet from any structure.
- 2. Bonfire shall not be greater than 4 feet x 4 feet in dimension.
- 3. Bonfire shall not burn longer than 3 hours.
- 4. Only seasoned fire wood may be burned for a bonfire. No burning of palettes, treated wood, brush, construction materials or rubbish is allowed at any time.
- 5. A garden hose must be available at the site of the bonfire at all times.
- 6. A rake or shovel must be available at bonfire site at all times.
- 7. A competent adult must be in attendance of the bonfire at all times.
- 8. Bonfire may be terminated by a police or fire department official if a neighbor finds the smoke offensive and complains.
- 9. A copy of the bonfire permit shall be presented at request of a police or fire representative or the bonfire shall be extinguished.

Please complete and return this form at least one week prior to the desired date of the

bonfire. If you have had a permit before, your new permit will be sent to you via e-mail. If you have not had a bonfire permit before, it will be issued when the inspector comes to your home, provided that the bonfire location is approved by the inspector.
