#### Vehicle Fire 7/5/2024

C Shift firefighters were called to a vehicle fire in the early morning following the 4<sup>th</sup> of July. Upon arrival, they found a pickup truck in a driveway on fire. The fire was primarily in the truck bed and spread to the passenger compartment. Ladder 2 arrived, and the crew successfully extinguished the fire with tank water from ladder 2. The driver of the pickup stated that discarded fireworks were placed in the bed of the truck. The fireworks had been watered down several hours earlier.



#### Firefighter of the Year Award 7/16/2024

The Optimist Club announced their annual Firefighter of the Year, and this year the award went to Edwin Prado. FF Prado started as a firefighter/EMT in August of 2017. He obtained his paramedic certification in 2019 and was promoted to full-time firefighter. FF Prado serves with an unmatched work ethic and willingness to hold over or come in on off days to ensure AHFD meets the community's needs.

#### <u>Trash Truck Fire</u> 7/19/2024



Dispatched toned C shift for a garbage truck fire. The truck pulled into a parking lot and dumped the trash that caught fire. Firefighters arrived to find areas of the truck also on fire. After successfully knocking down the bulk of the trash fire and fire in the truck, the trash company crew arrived with a skid steer to spread the trash around, allowing the firefighters to extinguish any remaining fire.
