ICS-300 and 400 3/27/2025



AHFD teamed with Oakland County Emergency Management-Homeland Security to lead an Incident Command System for Expanding Incidents Course, or ICS-300. Participants from the City of Auburn Hills, as well as local fire departments and law enforcement agencies followed FEMA curriculum for effective management during a large-scale emergency. A mass casualty incident was simulated as students took on various roles in order to mitigate and manage the crisis. In April, the same team taught ICS-400 to students interested in enhancing their knowledge on incident command for a complex and expanding incident.
