Fatal Crash Investigation (I-75 and Chrysler Drive)

On Friday, October 3, 2025, at approximately 12:56 am, personnel from the Auburn Hills Police and Fire Departments responded to a pedestrian crash on southbound I-75 and Chrysler Drive. Upon arrival a 40-year-old male from Oakland, MI was found to be deceased from injuries sustained from the crash. Preliminary investigation shows that the pedestrian was wearing all dark clothing and was actively crossing southbound I-75 when he was struck by a black Volkswagen Jetta. The pedestrian had been staying at a hotel in Auburn Hills adjacent to the freeway. The individual driving the Volkswagen Jetta, a 40-year-old man from Ohio, called 911after the crash, stayed on scene, and is cooperating with the investigation.

This crash is currently being investigated by the Southeast Oakland County Crash Investigation Team (SOCCIT). SOCCIT consists of crash investigators from Auburn Hills, Bloomfield Twp., Troy, Bloomfield Hills, Birmingham, and Clawson.
