

Commercial Fire

9/20/2025

A-shift was called to a commercial fire alarm on Opdyke. Engine 3 arrived on scene to discover offices full of smaoke and smoke exiting from exterior doors. Firefighters gained

entry into the building to find the fire confined to a single office. The sprinkler system kept the fire from escalating, and the extinguishers, carried by the crew, completely quenched the fire. The origin of the fire was a crate of lithium ion batteries that were being tested, but the cause remains undetermined.



Residential Fire

9/21/2025

Auburn Hills Fire Department's A-shift responded to a call for a structure fire. Upon arrival, crews found a working fire in the garage of a multi-family condo that had extended into the second floor of the home. Ladder 2 started the fire attack, then entered the condo to continue battling the blaze on the second floor.

Engine 3, Rochester Hills and Rochester City Fire
Departments arrived to assist with the fire attack. Rescue 1
arrived to assist with salvage and overhaul of the garage.
Rescue 3 began ventilating and Inspector Toss arrived to
investigate the origin and cause, which, at the time, remains
undetermined.
