3. Hydrant shall only be operated fully opened; flow control shall be accomplished by valve in the discharge line.4. Permittee shall install a back-flow preventer device or check valve in the discharge connection line if needed.								
 5. All DPW loaned equipment is to be returned in good condition; failure to do so will result in loss of the deposit. 6. A meter must be placed on any hydrant that has been issued a permit. A \$1,000.00 fine if meter is not used.
