NOTICE OF REGISTRATION FOR THE  
AUGUST 4, 2026 PRIMARY ELECTION**

To the Qualified Electors of the City of Auburn Hills, County of Oakland:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of Auburn Hills who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the City Clerk; the office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Registration forms can be obtained at [mi.gov/vote](http://mi.gov/vote) and mailed to the City Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at [www.expressSOS.com](http://www.expressSOS.com).

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is Monday, July 20, 2026.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at the Auburn Hills City Clerk’s Office, located at 1827 N. Squirrel Rd, Auburn Hills, MI 48326 at the following times:

- Regular business hours: Monday - Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m and Friday from 8:00 a.m. to noon.
- Saturday, August 1, 2026 from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- Election Day, Tuesday, August 4, 2026 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the election will be conducted in all voting precincts of the City of Auburn Hills for the purpose of electing candidates to the following offices:

CONGRESSIONAL	United States Senator Representative in Congress – 11 <sup>th</sup> District
LEGISLATIVE	State Senator – 7 <sup>th</sup> District Representative in State Legislature – 54 <sup>th</sup> District (Precincts 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7) Representative in State Legislature – 53 <sup>rd</sup> District (Precinct 1)
DELEGATE	Delegate to County Convention
JUDICIAL	Judge of Circuit Court, 6 <sup>th</sup> Circuit, Non-Incumbent Position Judge of Probate Court, Non-Incumbent Position
