GM Plant Tour

12/1/2025



All three shifts were invited to tour the new GM assembly plant on Lapeer Road, the site of the old Palace. Crews were shown the building, as well as the life safety systems and the fire pump. Firefighters were educated on how to shut down the pump, should this be necessary in the event of an emergency.

Commercial Fire

12/07/2025

C Shift was dispatched to a reported fire at Great Lakes Crossing. Upon arrival, a light haze was noted inside the windows and from the roof. Inside, crews began overhauling the area and stretched a water line. The fire was located and extinguished, while firefighters outside used an aerial ladder and water can to extinguish the fire on the roof. The building was ventilated and an Auburn Hills Fire Inspector conducted an investigation for origin and cause.

Mobile Home Fire

12/14/2025



C-Shift responded to a reported mobile home fire. Heavy smoke and flames were observed upon arrival. Crews encountered significant heat, smoke, and fire upon entry. Hand lines were stretched to combat the blaze, as it had extended into the attic and crawl space. Once extinguishment had been confirmed, the home was turned over to a board up company. The homeowner was treated for smoke exposure, but no other injuries were reported.

12/13/2025



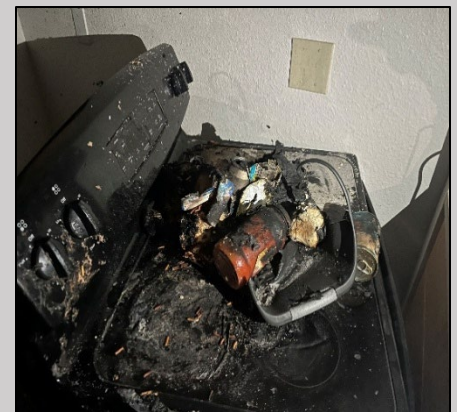

Structure Fire

12/20/2025

A-shift was called for a reported commercial structure fire at a local hotel. First responders noted light smoke coming from a room on the first floor. Items on the stove had ignited



from a burner set to high. The sprinkler system worked as intended, controlling the fire until firefighters confirmed the fire was completely out. Guests at the hotel had been evacuated. An AHFD Fire inspector was advised of the circumstances and followed up with management. Guests were advised they could return to the hotel. No injuries were reported.
