1/1/2026

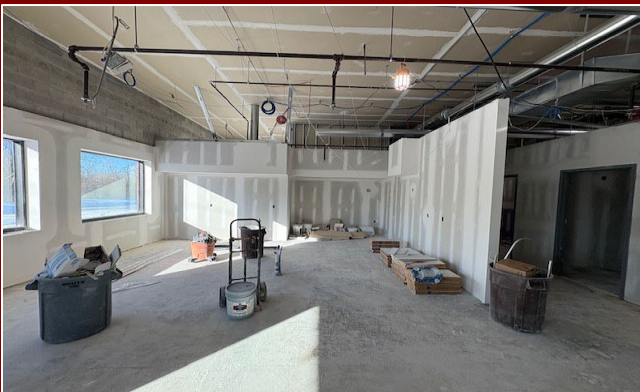
Station 1 is entering the final phase of construction.

- Flooring was recently completed
- Doors and some hardware have been installed
- Most cabinetry has been installed
- Electricians are making final electrical panel connections
- Fire alarm technicians are installing the suppression system devices
- Gear racks were recently installed
- Finish tile work will begin next week



Station 3 is approximately one month behind Station 1. This phase of construction is where paint, cabinetry, doors and flooring begin.

- All drywall is complete
- Bathroom tiling is in and will be grouted next week
- Electricians are currently running final connections to the new breaker panels
- Painters will be on site next week to start priming
- Millwork installations should begin as soon as painters are complete
