Residential Structure Fire

4/15/2026



A-shift was dispatched to a residential fire in the 3100 block of Auburn Rd. Upon arrival, Engine 3 found a 2-story single family structure with a working fire. Crews established water supply to attack the fire, using extreme caution due to an electrical hazard present. Rochester Hills, Bloomfield Township and Rochester fire departments all assisted on scene. Fire Inspector Toss arrived to conduct an investigation shortly after the fire was extinguished. The cause of the fire is undetermined. There were no reported injuries.
